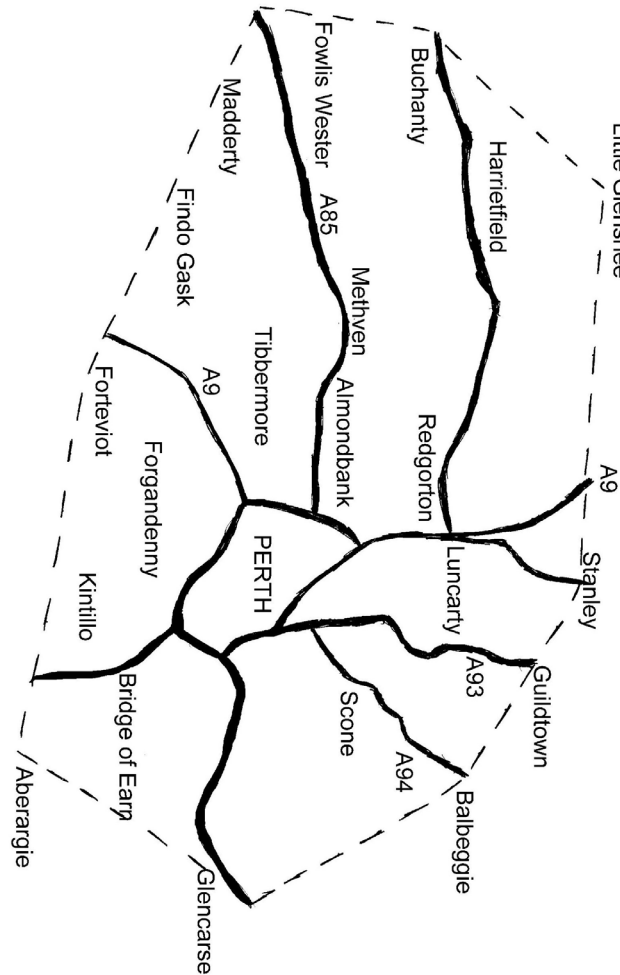

Emergencies

There is always a designated doctor on call to deal with emergencies during the normal 'In Hours' time.

Surgery Access

Pedestrian and wheelchair access from Glover Street. Ample parking including disabled parking.

Making an appointment

Telephone **639748** and ask for an appointment with the doctor you wish to see. For non-urgent problems you are able to book up to four weeks ahead. If the problem is urgent a doctor will see you as soon as possible. We also offer telephone consultations where appropriate as well as early morning appointments before 8.00am. Please ask the receptionist for details.

Home Visits

These are reserved for patients unable for medical reasons to attend the surgery. **Telephone 639748 before 10:30 a.m. if possible.** This allows the doctors to plan the visits more efficiently.

Emergency Out of Hours Calls

Emergency calls outside surgery hours are dealt with via NHS24 by the Primary Care Emergency Centre Perth Royal Infirmary. To contact a doctor out of hours telephone the surgery on **639748** and a recorded message will give you the number to call. Alternatively, call NHS24 directly on **08454 24 24 24**.

Repeat Prescriptions

Patients on regular prescriptions will be given a repeat prescription leaflet. Holders of these may order a prescription in one of the following ways:

- 1 Telephone **625542** and leave a request on the prescription voicemail.
- 2 Send us your leaflet (with a stamped addressed envelope) having marked which items you require.
- 3 Bring your leaflet to reception with your list.
- 4 Order online via the website: www.perth-and-methven-gp.co.uk. This operates using unique passwords which will be given to you on registering for the service.

We require at least two working day's notice for repeat prescriptions and longer at weekends or public holidays.

NB Non-repeat items may take longer than 48 hours to process. Please ask your local pharmacy about their prescription collection service.

NB Please **DO NOT** telephone 639748 for repeat prescriptions as this can block the line used for emergencies.

Cervical Smears

These can be carried out within the normal surgery by the doctor or nurse of your choice and are also available as part of a Well-Woman check-up. There is a standard three-yearly recall.

Contraceptive Services

Pill, Contraceptive Implant, Coil, other barrier methods and advice on sterilisation. You may consult any of the doctors for advice and for your regular check-up.

New Patients

Any patient over 15 years old who joins the practice will be offered an appointment with one of our nurses for a new patient examination. This is a condition of registration with the practice. If the patient is on several repeat medications or has a medical condition, they are requested to make an appointment with the doctor for registration.

Practice Nurses

Patients can make an appointment to see one of the nurses without having to see a doctor first. This service may be used for such things as stitch removal, wound dressing, ear syringing, breast examination, cervical smears and general health promotion advice.

Holiday Immunisations

Patients travelling abroad can see one of our nurses to arrange necessary immunisations and for general health care advice. There is a charge for this. Yellow Fever immunisation is not available from us, and some other unusual immunisations may attract a separate charge.

Other Information

Training: We are a training practice, which means that each year a fully qualified doctor with hospital experience works with us under supervision for one year to gain experience in General Practice. We also occasionally have medical or nursing students attached to the practice as observers. You will be advised if a student doctor or nurse will be present

Methven
